### **Policies & Procedures**

**Booth Requirements:** Each space is 10' x 10'. The vendor must supply all his/her own booth materials. There will be no tables, tarps, or shade cloths provided.

**Set-up:** Each vendor is responsible for set-up and takedown. Each vendor must be ready to sell by 8:30 am and sell until the event concludes at 4 pm

**Artist's and Vendor's Responsibility:** Terms and Conditions of Sales, Prices, Sales Tax, Delivery, and Insurance are the responsibility of the Artist/Craftsperson or Vendor. YVPC will not be responsible for losses due to theft, breakage, water, or other damage. The artist/craftsperson must be present to sell work. Artists/Vendors must possess a valid California Sellers Permit prior to participating. These may be obtained at the State Board of Equalization (224-4729). A copy of the permit must be attached to the application. Vendor vehicles will NOT be permitted within the staging area.
